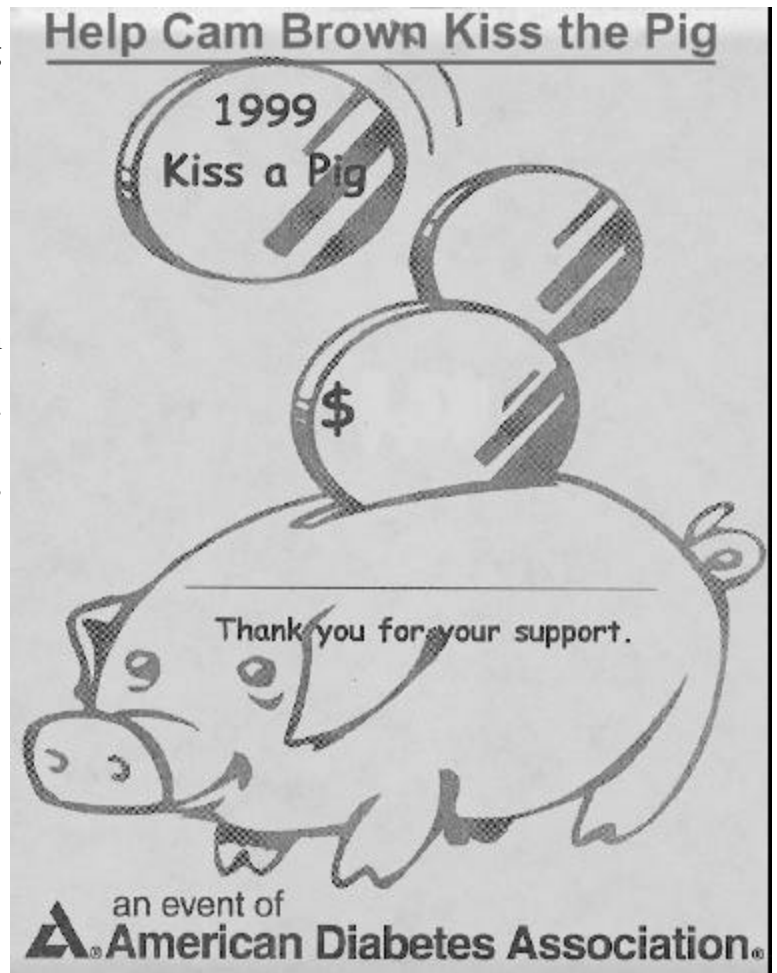

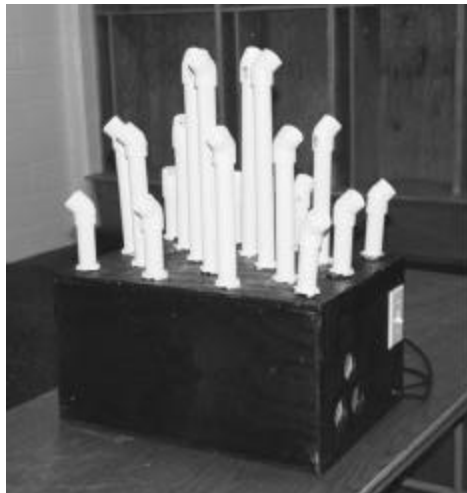

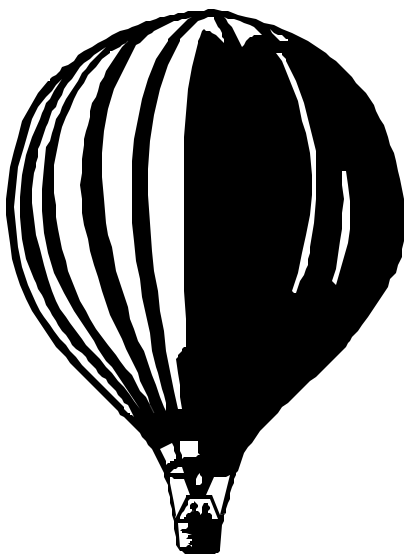

PICNIC '99'

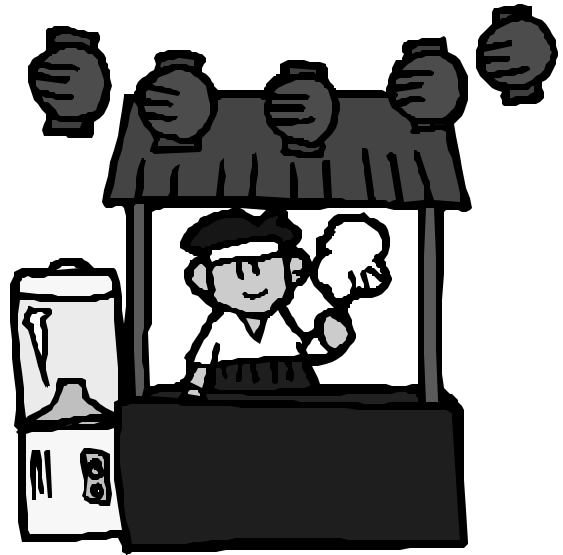
