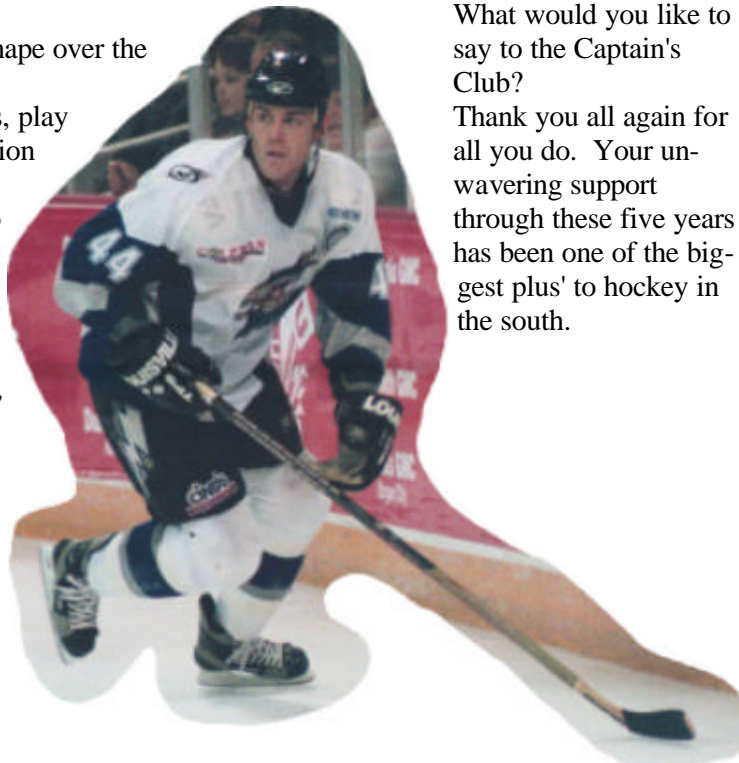

Great thanks to all that helped and all the cars and to Burger King.

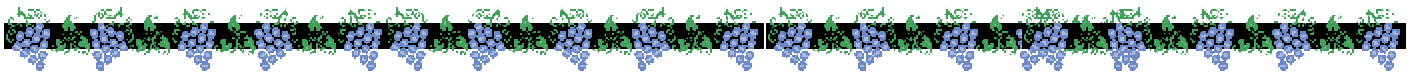
The Captains Club has reduced the price on our Golf and T-shirts. The new price \$10 for golf shirt and \$5 for T-shirts. We have

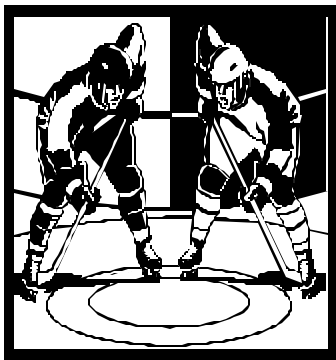
